CANCELLATION POLICY

If the stallholder withdraws with a minimum of one month notice, they will receive a full refund.
If the stallholder withdraws within one month of the event, there will be no refund granted.
If for any reason the event is cancelled by the committee, the stallholder will receive 50% refund.

SITE REGULATIONS

A maximum speed limit of 5km exists within the grounds of the event. Drivers must observe this speed limit at all times. Any drivers not observing this speed regulation or is driving recklessly may be evicted from the event.

At no stage shall anybody be allowed to ride on the back of a ute or truck.

All glass bottles and receptacles must be placed in the disposable areas as provided.

All Employees, Contractors, Suppliers and Volunteers shall ensure that all refuse and rubbish resulting from their works is placed and confined in suitable containers.

OBLIGATION AND ON-SITE REGULATIONS

All Employees, Contractors, Suppliers and Volunteers must conduct all works in a matter that eliminates or minimises the risk of bodily harm to any person or damage any property, so far as reasonably practicable, at all times.

All persons shall continuously monitor their operations at the work site and shall be responsible for ensuring the safety of all persons and property at all times.

ON THE DAY

All stalls shall be set-up and ready to begin the event at 11.00am sharp.

No stall shall begin to pack up at the end of the day until after 4.00pm, unless given had prior approval.

No vehicles shall be allowed within the grounds of the event until after 4.00pm, except with prior approval.
